



## **DRESS CODE POLICY**

Korowal School does not have a uniform. Our policy is that students' clothing should be appropriate to a school setting. It should

- enable freedom of movement
- provide adequate cover and sun protection

Footwear also needs to provide protection and allow for free movement during sport and PE lessons.

## **PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES**

Students dressed inappropriately will be informed that such clothing is not suitable for a school setting, this means that short-shorts, sleeveless baggy singlets and crop tops are not permitted. If worn, students will be required to cover up. Clothes with shoe string straps are permitted inside. In the event of continued inappropriate dressing, parents/carers will be contacted.

Underwear is not to be visible at any time.

T-shirts with negative messages or images are not acceptable and students wearing such tops will be asked to turn them inside out.

Hats providing protection for faces, ears and necks are required by PS students when the predicted UV reading is above 2. HS students are encouraged to take note of the lessons they have received regarding sun safety.

In cold weather beanies may be worn.

Open-toed shoes, sandals and thongs are not permitted.

Specialist subjects eg Art, Craft, Science, Design and Technology, PE, Sport and Outdoor Education have specific requirements to do with safety. Students will be informed of requirements by subject teachers.
