Terms and conditions of employment

This is a part-time position, 2 days per week (Monday and Tuesday), under the Independent Schools NSW (Professional and Operational Staff) HMEA. Classification General Hand, Level 2.1. The position is for 38 - 39 weeks per year (determined on calendar term dates) plus annual leave pro rata. Annual leave is to be taken during school holiday periods.

Working Environment

This position is for a Bus Driver for the Emu Plains bus run – to and from our campus in Hazelbrook. This is a split shift, with current regular hours of work being:

- Monday and Tuesday 7.00am to 9.30am and 3pm to 5pm

(These hours are based on current enrolments and may be subject to change.)

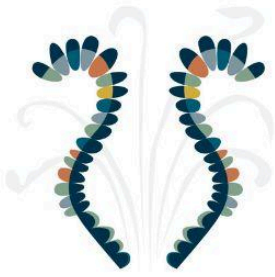
Additional driving for excursions, camps and bus servicing requirements may be requested and remains negotiable.

Selection Criteria *(these must be addressed in your application)*

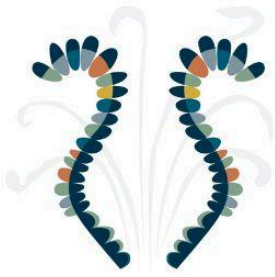
The successful applicant will have:
